

 - Expanding the original scope of FBD












Revamping FBD - Present

• Service:

 Small one-day projects/events. Rooted in volunteering and direct mutual aid

Design Engagement:

 Community-driven initiatives. May look very similar to design-builds, but the end result does not need to be a physical/built object

Design-Build:


Typical architecture/design approach





The process to uploading content!


- Easy access + sharing
