BOARD OF DIRECTORS

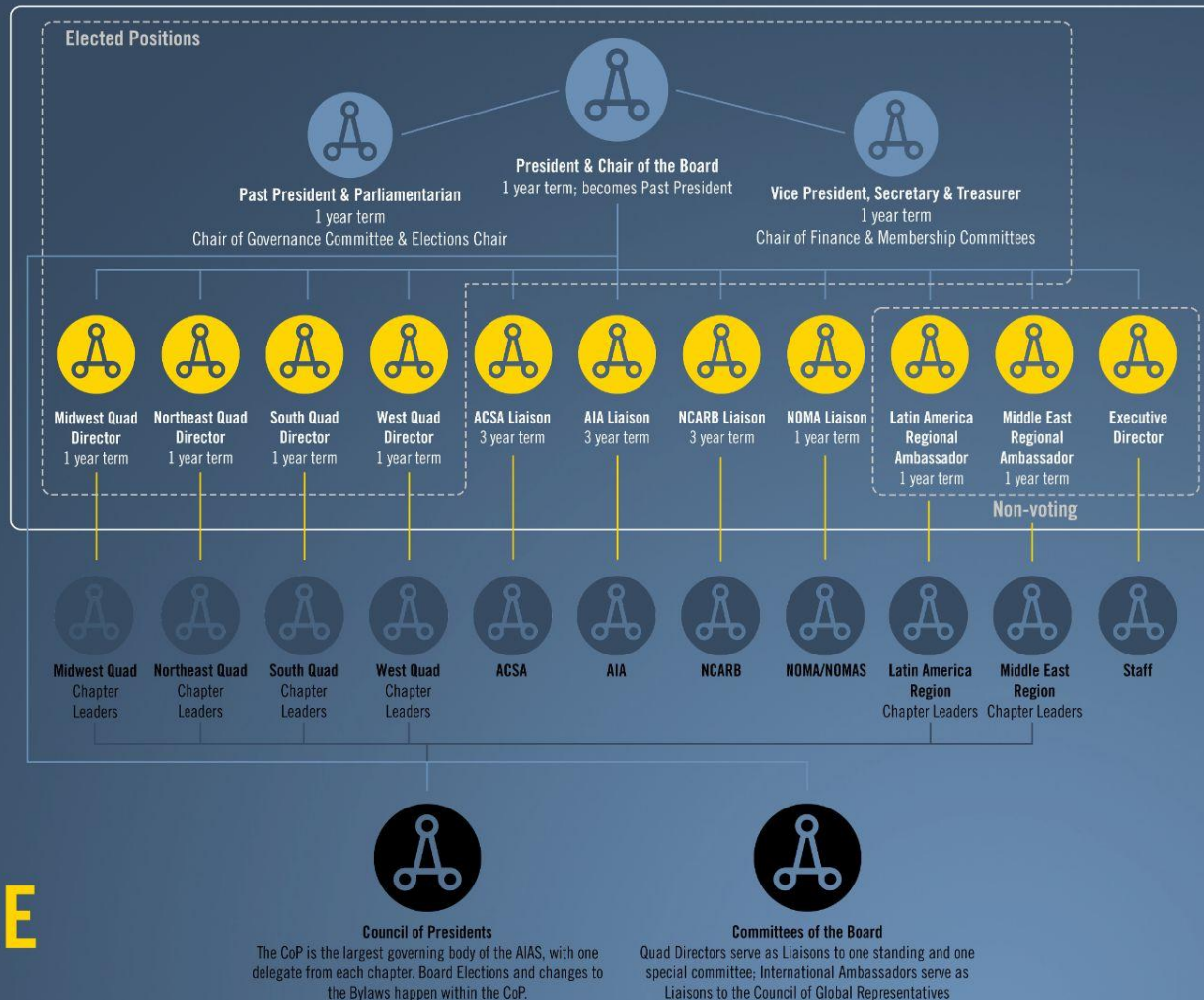


The President, Vice President, and Executive Director lead the organization from the **AIAS Headquarters in DC**, with the HQ Team.
