





" [...] No member may be excluded from membership on the basis of race, sex, religion, disability, national origin, or sexual orientation."









The most important thing you can do is listen to your members!




Know your why


Discuss value

Keep in mind all the value and benefits Nick discussed earlier in the presentation! We're dedicated to adding value to AIAS membership every day, so stick with us!






